Today, Lighthouse Christian School is still faithful to its original purpose, serves hundreds of students and families each year, and continues to be a vital part of the church's overall ministry to the community.

To honor God and in partnership with our school families, LCS is committed to the academic growth of each student. LCS understands that God has uniquely designed a plan for the life of each Lighthouse student. LCS desires to partner with parents to prepare each student for whatever God has created them to do, whether college, career, entrepreneurial experience, or ministry opportunity. The Lighthouse educational experience is student-formulated and teacher-facilitated, in a Christ-centered environment. We want students to engage in their educational experience and collaborate with others to challenge their thinking, identify their strengths,, and measure according to potential.



SCHOOL COMMUNITY



At Lighthouse Christian School, we are dedicated to:

- Encouraging students to develop a personal relationship with Christ, understand the Bible as God's infallible word, and be armed to defend their Christian beliefs.
- Helping students achieve academic excellence within their full potential, positioned to succeed at the next level of education and/or their chosen vocation.
- Guiding students to attain Christ-like character, good citizenship discipline, and perseverance through academic, athletic, and other extra-curricular programs and opportunities. Continuing development of a comprehensive educational program that helps guide each student in reaching their full academic, artistic, and athletic potential, partnering with parents in the education of their child.





ACADEMICS

Lighthouse Christian School is accredited through The Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). We serve a student body of 368 students and growing in grades K3-12th grade. As each child is a unique creation of God, we strive to foster and showcase individual gifts and talents of each child. Engaging lessons, challenging curriculum, highly qualified staff, and learner centered activities are offered at each stage of learning. Instruction is focused on the whole child.

Lighthouse offers a full preschool program for 3-4 year olds using a biblically based curriculum. Preschool students enjoy many of the same opportunities as our K-5 students including chapel, lunch, field trips, music, special programs, and recess. These integrated activities provide young learners with a foundation for their education and development.

Curriculum offered in grades K-5 is rigorous and research based with a focus on differentiated instruction in reading and math.

Math: iReady Mathematics offers ongoing assessment with targeted and adaptive online practice. Direct instruction and small groups are also part of this high-quality curriculum. We are currently in year two of implementation.

Language Arts: Collaborative Classroom is a literature rich, research-based program that offers individualized instruction in the areas of reading and writing. It also offers specialized, targeted instruction for struggling readers, which is our SIPPS program. Our SIPPS teacher pulls small groups of students with similar needs several times per week to focus on specific areas of reading instruction.

Science, Social Studies, and Social Emotional Learning: Students enjoy the hands-on experiences of Mystery Science, thematic studies for social studies, Idaho history in 4th grade, and Second Step for SEL.

Bible: Positive Action Bible studies is a developmentally appropriate Bible curriculum used across all grade levels and is a core subject area taught daily.

In grades 6-12, students are challenged and ready to enter the world of career, college, or vocation. English, math, science, social studies, foreign language, Bible, fine arts, agriculture, and athletics, along with various electives are all available to expose students to a well-rounded instructional experience. Opportunities include, worship band, choir, drama, STEM, college and career readiness, as well as upper-level mathematics and sciences.









LEARNING ENVIRONMENT

CAMPUS

Lighthouse Christian School is a PreK to 12th grade school that resides on a 10-acre campus in Twin Falls, Idaho.

Our Facilities Feature:

- A PreK- 5th grade elementary building with two classrooms for each grade level, a sanctuary, cafeteria, literacy room, prayer room, art room, finance office, administrative offices, and pastor offices.
- A 6th-12th grade secondary building with classrooms, a gymnasium, auditorium, weight room, concessions, and student services ofices.
- A music room for our choir, worship band, and elementary music classes.
- A Grindhouse fully equipped with a coffee shop and lunchroom for secondary students.
- A Football field equipped with one of the few turf football stadiums in the area.

The Lighthouse Lions have claimed 10 team state championships (Volleyball - 2012, 2013, 2014, 2016; Football - 2011, 2014, 2019; Track - 2013; Golf - 2014; Basketball - 2019) and multiple individual state championships. Lighthouse may be small, but the Lions are blessed with quality coaches, competitive student athletes and one of the few turf football stadiums in the area. CHRISTIAN SCHOOL

Lighthouse Church



Pastor Greg and Pam Fadness moved to Twin Falls in October of 1994 to establish what would become Lighthouse Church. Lighthouse Christian School was launched the following year under Pastor Greg's leadership. Greg and Pam's eldest daughter Caitlin was a part of the first graduating class in 2006. All five of the Fadness children attended and graduated from LCS.

Pastor Greg's vision for LCS is that it would go on into the future as a school where young people are given a strong biblical foundation, a rigorous education, and a passion to follow their God-given calling in life.

Church Board of Elders

Pastor Greg and the Pastors of Lighthouse Church continue to serve LCS by overseeing spiritual focus and biblical content, ensuring that LCS stays faithful to its mission

School Board of Directors

With the desire to honor the Lord Jesus Christ through the most effective operation of its school ministry, the church's Board of Elders has commissioned and delegated authority to a separate Lighthouse Christian School Board of Directors to provide focused oversight and direction for the school. Under the authority of the Lighthouse Church Board of Elders, and with authority granted to it by the church's Board of Elders, the LCS School Board of Directors is the governing body that provides the policies, direction, financial, spiritual, and operational accountability for the Head of School. The Head of School has authority over all school personnel and programs, is responsible for operating and managing all day-to-day affairs of the school, and reports directly to the LCS Board of Directors.



HEAD OF SCHOOL ROLE RESPONSIBILITIES

The Head of School reports to the Board of Directors as their sole employee. Consistent with its Policy Governance structure, the Board provides the Head of School with standards and measures for accountability. The Board of Directors currently consists of five members. The Head of School is charged with the overall responsibility for the operation of the school in accordance with the by-laws, policies, and end result objectives approved by the Board.

The Head of School will provide Christ-centered, biblically based, and spiritual leadership to all aspects of the school, and will be responsible for all day-to-day business, spiritual, academic, and co-curricular operations. Additionally, the Head of School will be the chief spokesperson for Lighthouse Christian School with the various constituencies of the LCS community: students, parents, staff and faculty, alumni, donors, community leaders, organizations, Board of Elders, and the Board of Directors.

SPIRITUAL LEADERSHIP

The Head of School provides spiritual leadership through a powerful Christian testimony and witness, a humble spirit, and a heart guided by prayer. The Head of School is responsible for ensuring students can grow and develop with the foundation of God's truth and for fostering the spiritual vitality of the faculty and staff so they can positively influence students. The Head of School will model a Christ-like attitude and lifestyle and demonstrate compassion, patience, honesty, and wisdom in all interactions with staff, students, parents, board members, and other community members.

ADVANCEMENT LEADERSHIP & FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT

The Head of School will ensure internal professional business processes and operations to safeguard integrity and sustainability. The Head of School will also ensure external promotion of the school to the broader Magic Valley community, enhancing Lighthouse's reputation to increase enrollment and donor investment. The Head of School monitors enrollment trends and seeks to understand what is driving those trends. He or she also oversees the operation of the business office including IT, accounting/finance, communications, and building maintenance. As the face of the school, the Head of School is strategically engaged with donors to the school and sharing opportunities to partner in the school's exciting mission.

ACADEMIC LEADERSHIP

The Head of School provides academic leadership by directing his or her team in the improvement of instruction, curriculum alignment, supervision of staff, selection of curriculum, and administration of disciplinary action for students and staff. The Head of School is responsible for developing a program of professional development to maximize staff growth, advancement, and academic excellence.

ORGANIZATIONAL LEADERSHIP

The Head of School provides strategic and visionary leadership for the entire organization to reach the end result objectives established by the Board. He or she collaborates with and supervises the leadership team, ensuring they effectively lead all other staff in the accomplishment of strategic goals and initiatives for the purpose of fulfilling the LCS mission and vision.

COMMUNICATION SKILLS

The Head of School will be a unifying and effective communicator who establishes and maintains strong personal relationships with internal and external constituencies, speaking Lighthouse's values in the school community in words and writings, and living them out through the ministry of presence.
